Student Social Events

Classroom Parties

1. End of the Year Parties

There shall be no end of the year school picnics or school parties off the school grounds.

2. Birthday Parties

Student birthday parties during the school day may be scheduled, but are not to begin earlier than 15 minutes before dismissal time.

3. Other Parties

Halloween parties, Christmas parties, and Valentine Day parties are the only other parties that may be scheduled and are to begin no earlier than one hour before the end of the school day.

All Christmas trees displayed in the schools must meet the fire code of Marion. No electric lighting will be used.

Student Insurance Program - General

An all-pupil insurance program may be offered to the parents of pupils in the district. The Board of Directors upon recommendation of the Superintendent shall select the insurance company to issue such policies for all schools in the district.

The purchase of pupil insurance shall be voluntary with the entire cost being paid by the student, his/her parents, or guardian.

Board Policy Number 504.21

School Attendance for Students with AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome)

A student with AIDS should be able to attend school as long as they are physically able to perform the tasks assigned to them and as long as their attendance does not create a substantial risk of transmission of the infection to other students or district employees.

The district staff and administration shall develop guidelines concerning the management, exclusion, re-entry, and associated treatment of students and staff who have AIDS. In-service education of appropriate school personnel should ensure that proper medical and current information about AIDS is available.
